The information collected by these cookies is aggregated and anonymous, meaning it does not identify you personally.

#### **Customer Experience Cookies**

These cookies help us understand how users interact with our website and app. They track anonymous data about:

- Which sections of our website are most frequently visited.
- User navigation patterns and interaction with content.
- Errors encountered and areas needing optimization. This information is used to improve the overall user experience by refining layouts and simplifying user journeys.

## **Functionality Cookies**

These cookies enhance the functionality of our website by remembering your preferences and past interactions. For example, they:

- Store your login credentials for faster future logins.

Targeting cookies are used for marketing purposes. These cookies:
